  - The tour will be unique and personal, based on your time at Stanford. It can range from showing your favorite café or reading spot to your dorm or favorite classroom
  - The tour is not a Wikipedia history tour, although taking time for some famous photo spots and ancient Stanford myths and legends is always welcome
- Being flexible and able to work 8+ hour days during program.

### **Requirements:**

- Applicants should have an interest in education, international cultures, global issues, travel, and/or Japan.
- Applicants must be fluent in English (No Japanese language skill required)
- Applicants must be familiar with the San Francisco Bay Area and feel confident leading students.
- Applicants do **NOT** need to be able to commit to all the dates in a given program. Preference may be given to applicants who are able to commit to all dates/times.
