 - Encouraging students to exercise leadership and initiative throughout the day.
 - Being responsible and confident in acting as a guide and following safety procedures such as continually performing headcounts, etc.
 - Being flexible and able to make quick and educated decisions.
 - Working effectively in a team environment and following instructions from the Head Coordinator and GPI Staff.

Requirements:

- Applicants should have an interest in education, international cultures, global issues, travel, and/or Japan.
- Applicants must be fluent English speakers (no Japanese language ability required).
- Applicants must be current undergraduate or graduate students OR recent graduates.
- Applicants must be familiar with the Boston/Cambridge area and feel confident navigating the public transportation system while leading students.

Dates & Compensation:

- There are several 4-8 hour opportunities throughout March and April 2019.
- Compensation is dependent on the length of session but ranges from \$60 - \$130 per session. Any admissions with saved receipts will be covered. Any meals during the activity are already included in the compensation.
