Requirements:

- Fluent English speaking and writing ability (No Japanese language skill required)
- Ability to confidently lead facilitate discussion sessions
- Being flexible and able to make quick, educated decisions
- Applicants do **NOT** need to be able to commit to all the dates in a given program. Preference may be given to applicants who are able to commit to all dates/times.
