



## **Empowerment/Leadership Facilitator for Japanese High School Students**

- Leading classroom management and guiding Discussion Leaders through small group activities (the majority of the class will be conducted in small groups with university students serving as Discussion Leaders).
- Facilitating discussions, engaging students, and taking direction from the GPI US Head Coordinator when applicable.
- Being able to revise lesson plans on the spot depending on the students' ability and time constraints.

### **Requirements:**

- Interest in education, international cultures, global issues, travel, and/or Japan.
- Experience teaching international high school students (preferred).
- Fluent English speaking and writing abilities (No Japanese language skill required).
- Commitment to all program dates/times (session lengths may vary from 2-4 hours).
- Ability to confidently lead and facilitate sessions.
- Flexibility and being able to make quick, educated decisions.
